Grafix Black Chipboard Grafix Double Tack Mounting Film® Grafix Inkjet Printable Transparency with adhesive backing (Computer Grafix Film) Grafix Inkjet Printable Vellum® Inkjet Printer Copier Scissors Vintage Map

Directions:

1. Adhere vintage map onto the chipboard using double tack.

2. Make a copy of a handwritten page on the transparency film.

3. Cut out a square "window opening" in the

transparency film, remove paper liner and adhere to map.

4. Print purple flowers onto vellum, cut out and adhere to artwork with double tack.
